Dutch national. Studied Law at Rotterdam and Leyden University.

Roeland – currently employed at the Dutch Ministry of Infrastructure and Water management - followed a civil servant carrier path as a policy associate on (pre 1989) East-West conflict resolution, Trade and Foreign Direct Investments in East Asia, European Defense cooperation, the military industrial complex, the liberalisation of the European telecommunications market and supply chain security. Roeland held project management positions in City logistics, multimodal transport, digitization of freight transport and logistics and Maritime Single Window implementation. In 2018, author of the Dutch Digital freight Transport Strategy, issued as a White paper to Parliament in 2018.

Since 2019, Roeland is coordinator of the EU CEF project FEDeRATED, assisting the EU to establish a EU future proof data sharing environment in logistics and freight transport. The project is executed by 15 partners, both from the business communities (including IATA) and public authorities, covering 6 EU Member States. Some 22 LivingLabs, covering various data sharing business cases, are ongoing, aimed at validating a Masterplan for a decentralized data-based future in EU logistics. Beginning 2024, the validated Masterplan will be published as a final project delivery.
